Dr Cathy Franzi: Botanical Ceramics

Cathy Franzi is a ceramic artist working and living in Canberra and a recent PhD graduate in the Ceramics workshop at the School of Art & Design at the Australian National University. The subject of her work stems from doing what she loves, that is to be in nature, and plants are her particular fascination. With this attention, comes a recognition of environments under threat and species in rapid decline. Her work aims to reflect the textural and formal qualities of plants and refer in some way to the connections between them, ecosystems they inhabit, and attributed cultural values. Through her work she investigates ways in which representations of Australian flora on the ceramic vessel can express current botanical and environmental knowledge.

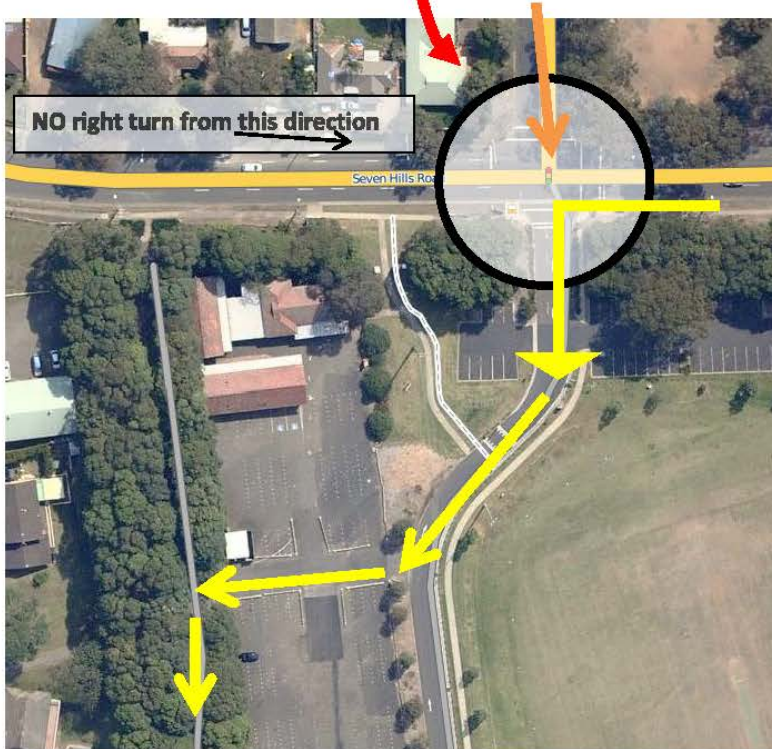
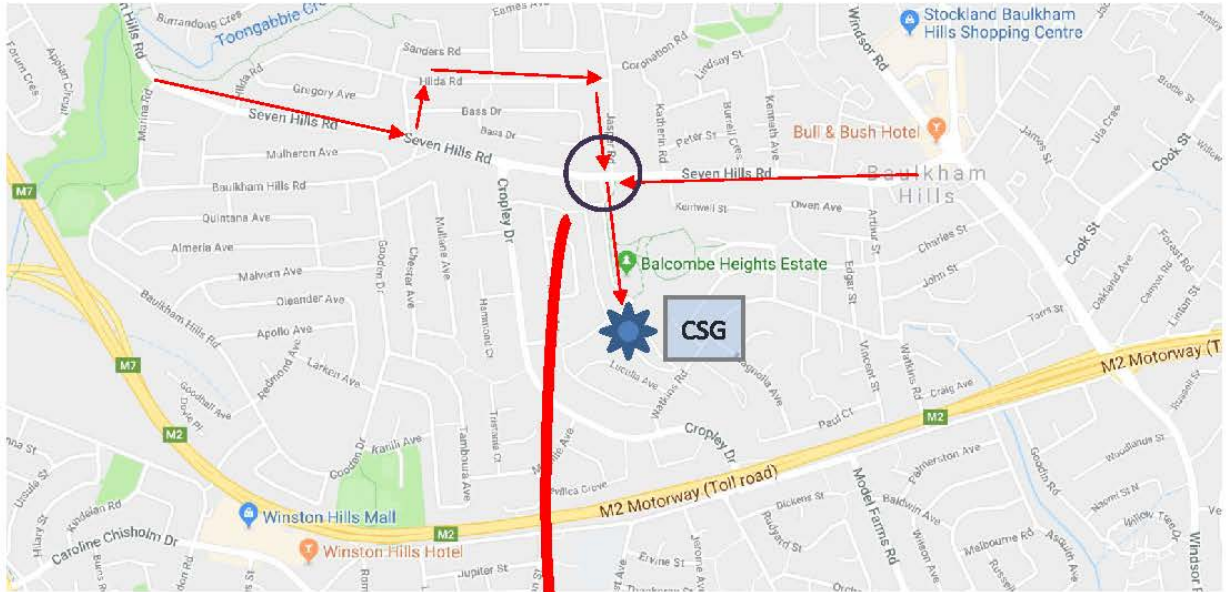
