Liz Trujillo completed a Diploma in Ceramics from East Sydney Tech in 1985 and after leaving college focused on sculptural ceramics for a good 30 years. Liz joined the Inner City Clayworkers and was a member during the 90s, exhibiting regularly. Liz has always had an interest in all art and craft forms and over the years has continued to work with fabric, metal jewellery and lately painting. After moving to Wollongong, Liz established her home studio and though constrained by a small kiln continued to produce her whimsical figurative works for a series of group and solo shows.

For a few years ceramics took a back seat to her other creative interests, but recently has emerged with a new impetus. Her work is largely about the female figure and she continues to reference feminine mythology. Her imagery is unique as is her technique for painting onto the fired clay.

During the workshop, Liz will describe her journey and build her figures, demonstrating her construction technique and her method of painting her work.

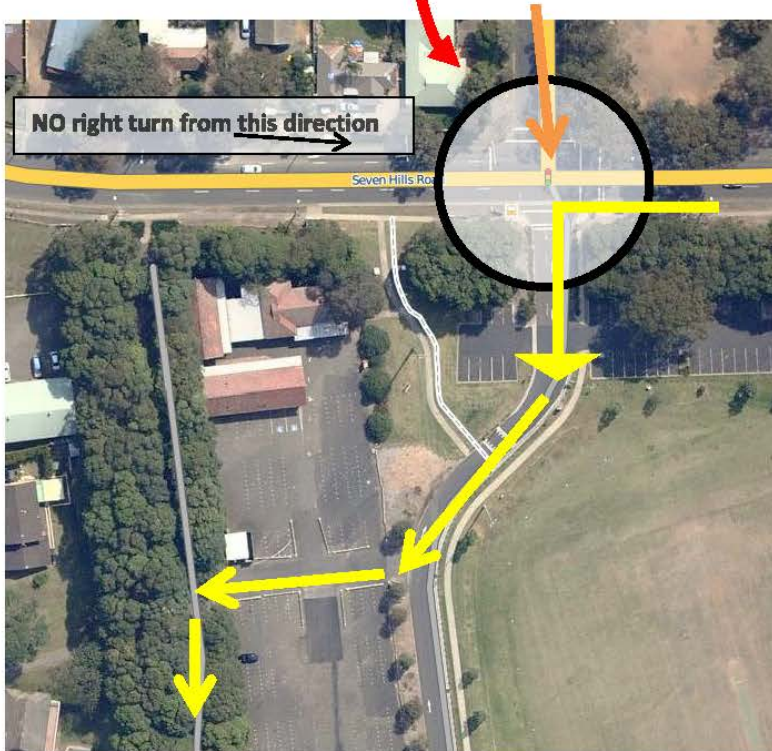
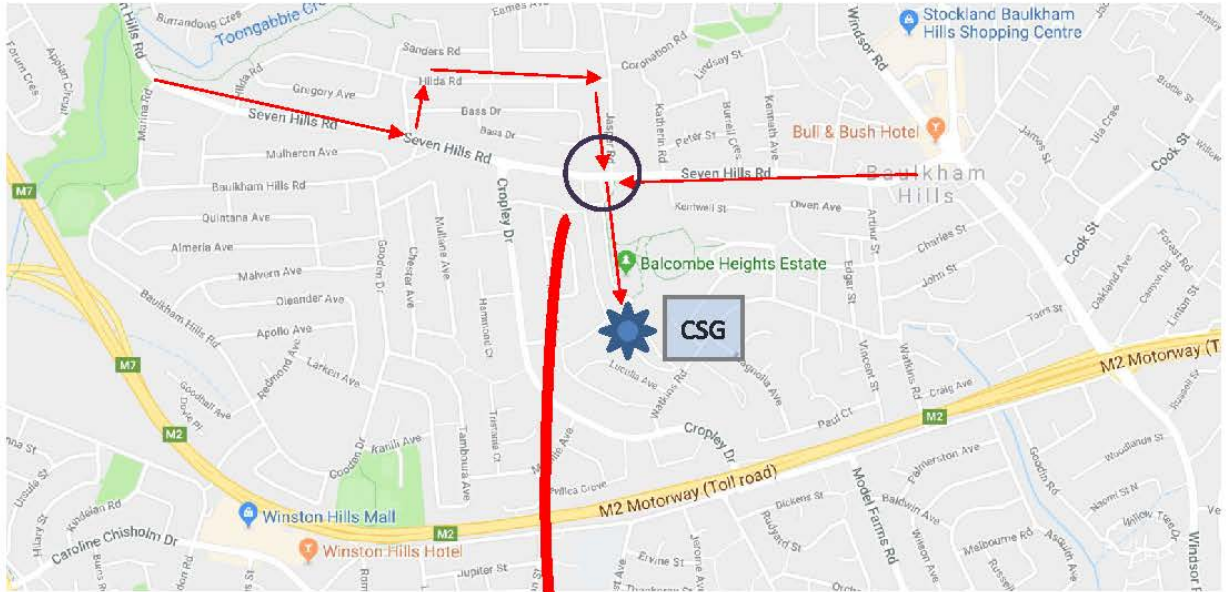
