Malcolm returned to Australia in 1980, working in clay on a part time basis until 1989, when he left the corporate world, to begin a career as a full-time potter. He was trained at TAFE and completed his Advanced Diploma in Ceramics in 2019.

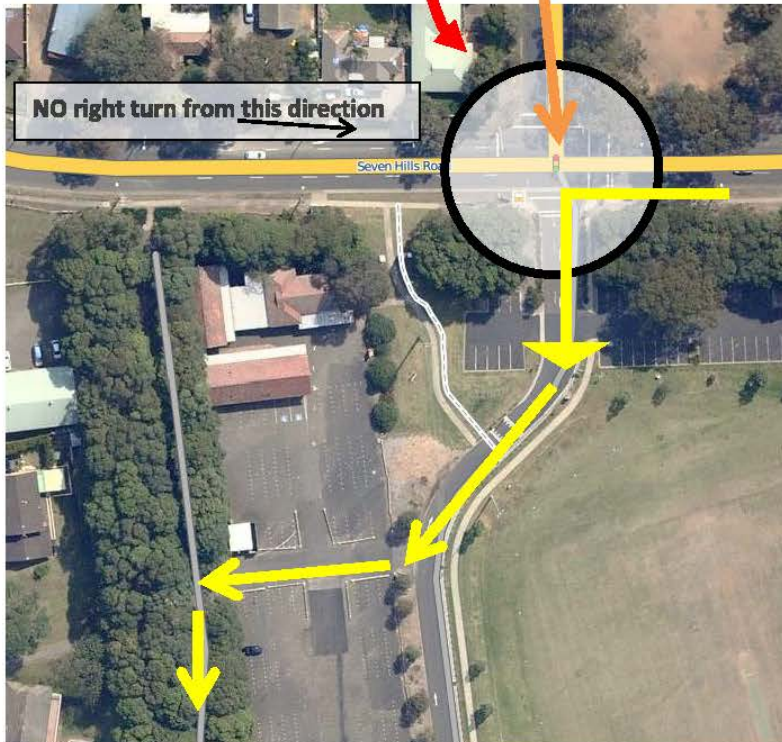
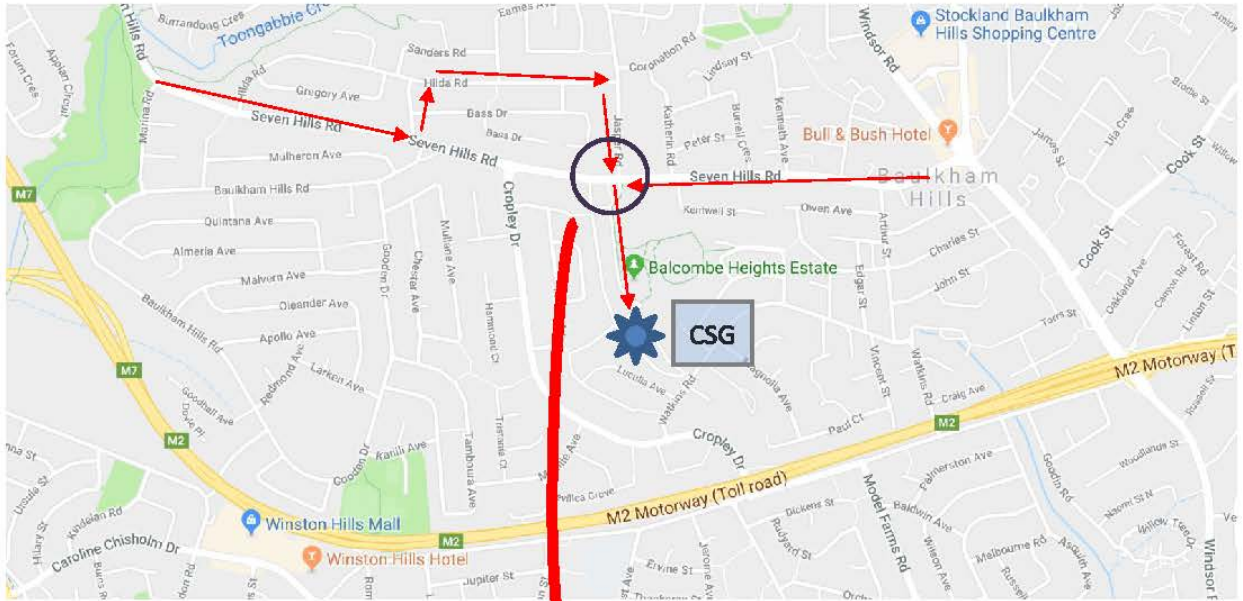
