The Social Life of a Papua New Guinean Cooking Pot

Anna-Karina Hermkens studied for two years at the Academy of Fine Arts in Maastricht, Netherlands and has a Diploma in Ceramics from TAFE Hornsby and a PhD in cultural anthropology with a focus on ethnographic art, religion and gender studies.

Anna-Karina will give a presentation, focusing on a handmade vessel from Papua New Guinea. Made by elder Ruth in a small, coastal hamlet in PNG and used as a cooking pot and part of local gift exchanges in neighbouring village, it ended up traveling with

Anna-Karina across the globe and turning into a “conversation piece”.

Anna-Karina will also give a quick demonstration of a particular technique allowing participants to try it out themselves as well.



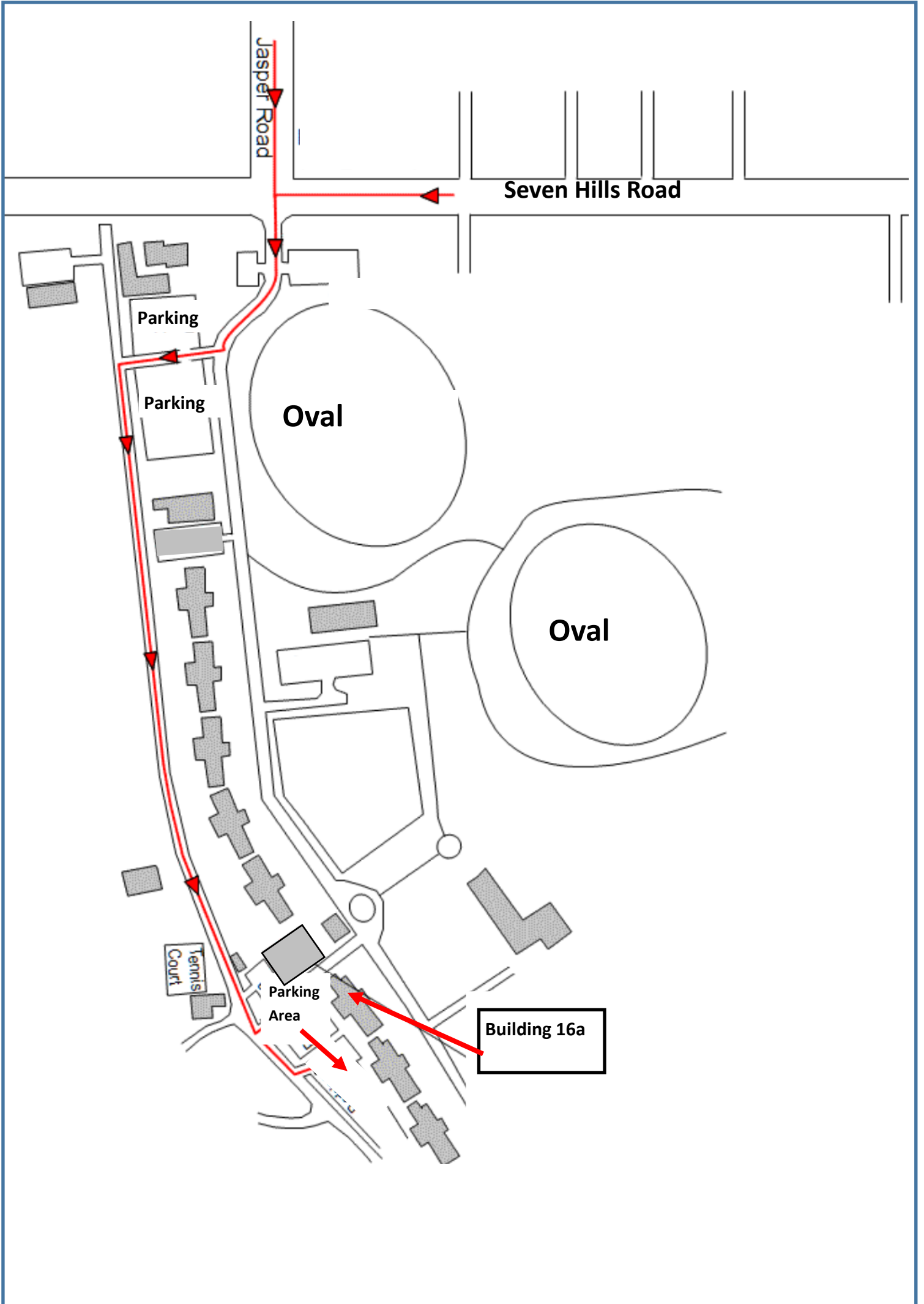

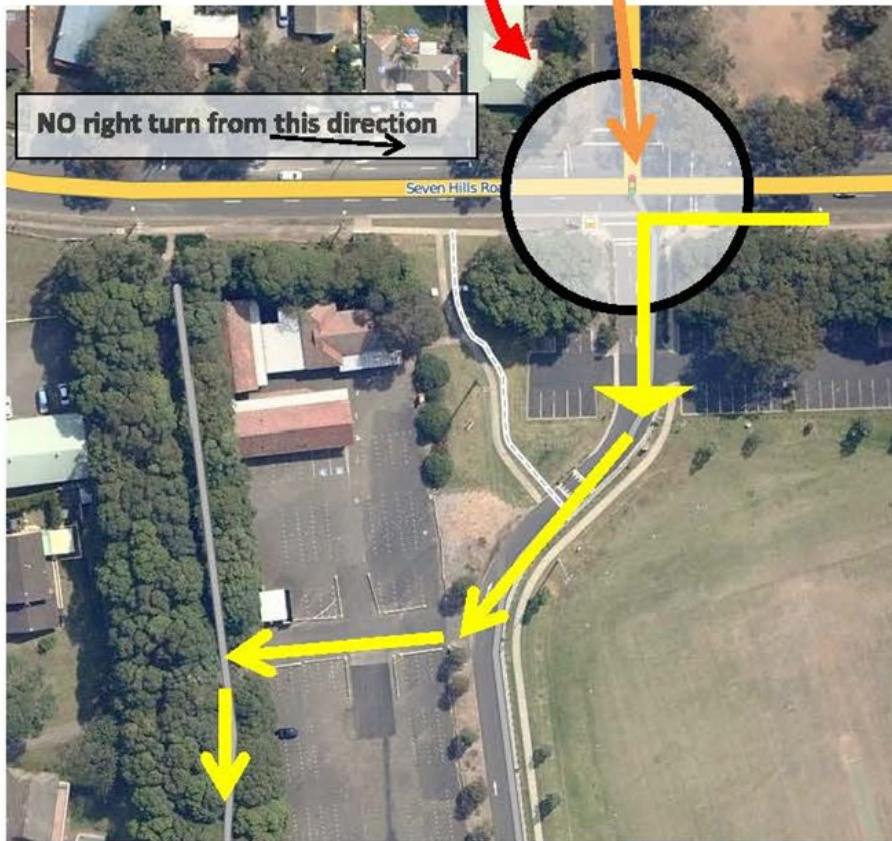
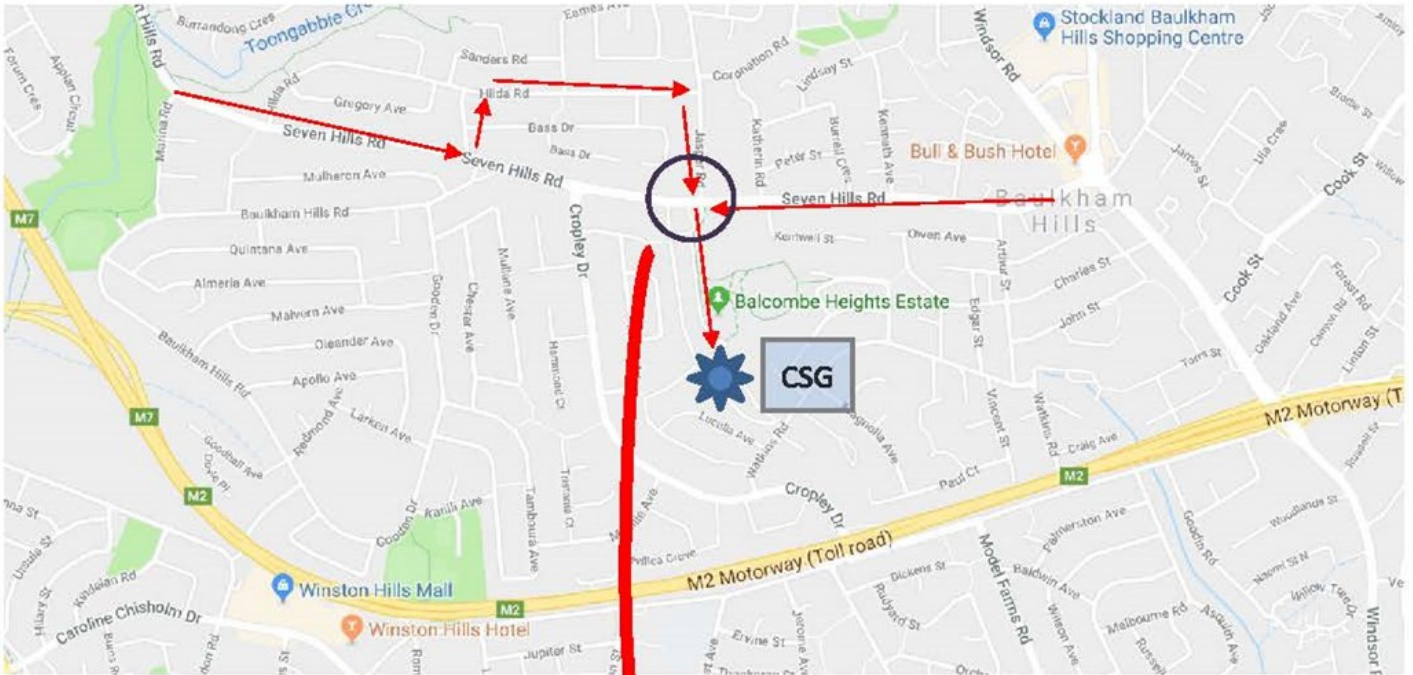
