KWAK KYUNG TAE – ONGGI MASTERCLASS WORKSHOP

For three days, the Ceramic Study Group is excited to be hosting the **only** Sydney based Intensive Onggi workshop with renowned Korean ceramicist, **Kwak Kyung Tae**, one of the last few living representations of this craft.

Students will learn the unique, ancient technique of making large pots, known as Onggi, used traditionally for fermentation and storage in Korea.

This is a hands-on workshop with the master Kwak Kyung Tae, learning how to coil, paddle and shape the form, using a set of particular, wooden tools. The goal is for students to leave with a solid grasp of this technique and have the confidence to apply them in their studio.

Discussions on adapting this technique for contemporary needs, firing tips, etc will also be covered in this once in a lifetime workshop opportunity.

To ensure plenty of one on one training, places for the workshop will be limited to 14 people.

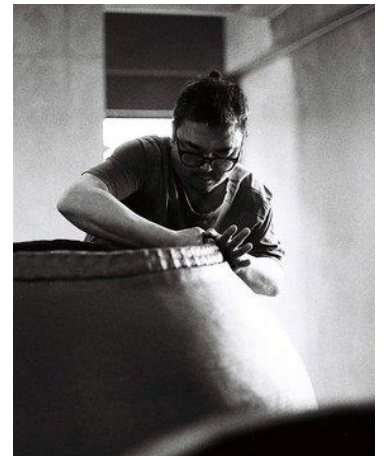
Be sure you book early to avoid disappointment in missing out, on what promises to be an unforgettable workshop.
